

All our roses are grown in containers, but have only been potted during the winter. Therefore, they will not be rooted through until later in the spring. Please be especially careful when it comes to planting out your roses. If in any doubt, please ask for advice. Some of the new varieties are only available in low numbers. Throughout the year we buy in more Roses, so if you are looking for a certain variety or larger numbers, please let us know.

AGM—Award of Garden Merit

Plant given the AGM by the RHS must be:

- Available to purchase
- Outstanding excellence for ornamental or other use
- Must be of good constitution
- Must NOT require highly specialist growing conditions or care
- Must NOT be particularly susceptible to any pest or disease
- Must NOT revert too much

GS Gold Standard

Gold Standard identifies Roses that are the healthiest, hardiest and bring something new to the market. This is an industry led trial run by The National Institute of Agricultural Botany and the British Association Representing Breeders.

Care and Maintenance

Pests and diseases

Roses can be susceptible to black spot and attack from greenfly. A programme of hygiene and good husbandry can reduce or remove the need for chemicals. Please ask for advice in the shop.

Feeding

Roses are very hungry plants and will benefit from regular feeding through the season, not just once in the spring. Incorporate generous amounts of well rotted manure or use a general fertiliser when planting and mulch annually to keep your plants healthy. It is well recognised that well fed plants are far less prone to disease.

Pruning

This is a topic all on its own, and for specific advice, please don't hesitate to ask. However, with all roses the best time to prune them in Cornwall is during January and February. Dead heading during the summer will also prolong the display from most bush varieties. If it is a shrub rose that also gives a good hip display, don't dead head as you'll get no hips.
