HOW TO GROW ROSES SUCCESSFULLY

PLANTING YOUR ROSE:

Start with choosing a sunny position in your garden or for your container. You will need at least half a day of sunshine (and the more the better), with good, manure rich soil which is not waterlogged. The compost for growing a rose in a container should contain a high percent of John Innes No3 mixed with a bit of multipurpose compost.

When starting a new rose bed, you might want to consider investing in some Rootgrow (mycorrhizal fungi) to give the plant the best start possible. Plant the grafting point just below the soil surface.

FEEDING YOUR ROSE:

Roses are very hungry plants. Feeding your rose throughout the summer is important for a succession of flowers and healthy growth. You could use a diluted tomato feed or a special rose feed.

Roses can certainly cope with periods of drought, but your rose bushes will produce more flowers if they are not allowed to dry out, certainly not in the first two years after planting. Please water in the morning and avoid getting the leaves wet.

PRUNING YOUR ROSE:

Pruning is very important for your roses, but don't worry, better to trim too much than not enough. This job is best carried out in the winter (November untill early March). Here in Cornwall, it is recommended to finish pruning by January, because of the mild winter and potentially early spring.

For bush, patio and ground cover roses the following rough guide applies: Cut out all broken and weak shoots and trim the remaining ones back by a third to an outward-facing bud. During the flowering season trim out all spent flower heads to encourage new growth. Some shrub roses also give a good hip display, so be careful not to deadhead.

Any climbers and ramblers should be trained over an obelisk and along fences in the late summer and autumn and the vertical stems should be shortened to 3cm.

ROSES AND DISEASES:

A lot of customers worry about black spot and other fungal diseases that affect roses. Always choose a variety which has been recommended by the rose grower for healthy growth (look out for AGM awards and Gold Standards). Try to follow the instructions above, well-fed/ watered roses are less likely to suffer from black spot.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

All our roses are sold in containers, and will have been potted during the winter. Therefore, they will not root through the pot until later in the spring, so be especially careful when planting out your roses.


AWARD OF GARDEN MERIT


